Les Diamants: A New Quebec Creation to Start Touring the Province This Summer!

A first coproduction involving five host cities in Quebec

Montreal, May 20, 2021 – The Quartier des Spectacles Partnership, the Société de développement de l'avenue du Mont-Royal, the Borough of Rivière-des-Prairies–Pointeaux-Trembles, Culture Trois-Rivières and Montréal centre-ville are pleased to announce the winners of the *Intervalle* call for proposals put out in summer 2020. Francis Laporte and Alexis Laurence of Perséides studio have been named the competition's winners for their proposed project *Les Diamants*, composed of three large rotating and sparkling structures that will light up public spaces day and night. The interactive installation will tour the province starting this summer with plans to visit five cities and boroughs in Quebec. By involving several neighbourhoods and cities right from the start, this Quebec coproduction is breaking new ground. The *Intervalle* call for proposals aimed to give artistic creators an opportunity to design and present an interactive public installation at five partner sites over the course of the year. The installation is a joint collaboration of two creators who are well known here and internationally: Francis Laporte and Alexis Laurence of Perséides studio. They are working primarily with the manufacturing team at the company **Jack World**, making their installation a 100% local creation.

Les Diamants is an interactive work composed of three colourful, luminous structures that activate and "come alive" when spun like gigantic tops. In the daytime, the many rods with their ultra-shiny finish reflect the ambient light; at night, they light up in a whirl of glittering dots and lines. Each module delivers a distinct musical ambience featuring an original melody, composed by **Stefie Shock**, that speeds up or slows down depending on the speed of rotation. When several people work together to get each structure turning, the work creates a harmonious dance of light and music that is a treat for the eyes and ears. "*Les Diamants* was born of Alexis' and my desire to combine our expertise and undertake a joint unifying project during the pandemic. We want to encourage people to get out, come together and reoccupy our public spaces. Our goal is to create a moment of poetry between participants and for the work to bring joy and entertainment to the citizens of the Quebec cities hosting the installation," said **Francis Laporte, Co-Creator, of Perséides studio.**
